

PERFORMANCE WORK STATEMENT

EXHIBIT STORAGE, SUPPORT AND SHOW SERVICES/MATERIALS

1.0 INTRODUCTION

This contract is for support of Team SPAWAR's exhibit program and will include designing, building, maintaining, modifying, and setting up exhibits for use in trade shows, conventions, and symposia. Exhibits are based on modular exhibit systems that are customized for each show to meet the marketing and communication objectives of Team SPAWAR management, including subordinate commands and Program Executive Offices (PEO). Schedules are unpredictable with quick turn-around times and critical deadlines. Work may involve some overtime and travel. The support required involves a variety of exhibit system structures including the major SPAWAR-owned exhibit system (TRUSS & SCRIM), and other smaller modular systems such as the OCTANORM System, and the setup at of these structures at various show locations.

2.0 SCOPE

This contract provides for new custom-built or modular systems, storage, preparation, maintenance, and modification of structures, shipment to and from shows, drayage, setup and teardown, and cleaning of exhibits. It will also include strategic planning for the design and production of graphics products utilized for each show. The graphics products will communicate Big Navy and Team SPAWAR key messages, highlighting the organization's capability and ensuring that messages align with the theme of each exhibition. It will also include coordinating exhibit show services for each exhibition, which includes arranging all facility requirements for setting up the exhibit, and coordinating efforts with the labor unions that oversea execution at various exhibition venues.

3.0 TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

3.1 CLIN X001 Storage and Inventory Requirements

The Contractor shall provide for storage of SPAWAR-owned exhibit systems and support materials and ensure that they are protected from extremes of moisture and temperature, known pests, vandalism, unauthorized use or appropriation, and destruction from fire or flood.

See Exhibit B for the current inventory of exhibit materials. Approximately 6,000 cubic feet of storage space is needed to store these Government owned materials. The Contractor shall maintain a current inventory (including photographs) of all exhibition materials, both Government furnished and Contractor acquired. The Contractor shall maintain a current inventory of all exhibit graphics that have been used at previous shows. The Contractor shall move the entire inventory to their storage facility, from the incumbent's, at the start of this contract.

3.2 CLIN X002 Exhibit Support Services

The Contractor shall perform the following exhibit support services as necessary for each exhibition: Provide consulting services to the Contracting Officer's Representative (COR) or other Government Representative to discuss the planning objectives and expected outcomes of each exhibition. Pull exhibit materials from

storage based on the needs of the show and the configuration selected. If exhibit materials in storage are not sufficient to meet show requirements, design and produce a new system that will meet specific requirements as agreed upon with the COR or Government Representative. As required, the Contractor shall set-up the exhibit within the Contractor's storage facility for the purposes of inspection and design planning of exhibit elements and panels. The Contractor shall grant access to their facilities to the COR and/or Government Representative for these purposes.

The Contractor shall modify exhibit systems as specified on Government task orders. When possible, Contractor shall utilize existing materials in storage to meet the requirements of the Government and show floor plan specifications. This include the following: Refurbish, clean, and repair the exhibit as required. Clean and repair or replace carpet as required. Exhibit materials shall be maintained free of noticeable wear, tear, and visible damage. Modify, reconfigure, or update exhibits and graphics as required by the Government to reflect new show requirements, such as modifying electrical harnesses within the exhibit. Fabricate and integrate counter tops, doors, support units, and cabinetry. Perform load-engineering services and reconfigure exhibit structure. Fabricate stainless steel panels and framework for exhibit system. Construct models for the exhibit, utilizing existing systems and materials listed in **Attachment B** whenever possible.

The Contractor shall also provide graphic design services and produce new graphics and graphic panels as required for each show. Contractor Working closely with the COR or Government Representative on strategic planning during strategic planning sessions, the Contractor will develop messaging to form the basis for graphics utilized for each particular exhibition and ensure that Big Navy and Team SPAWAR key messages are communicated in all products. Establish a photo resource to provide photos for exhibits and graphics production. Prepare, mount, and process large photo murals and large digital signs foam-core, sintra, plexiglass or other panels for use as part of the exhibit. Retouch photographs as needed. Laminate large murals in accordance with specifications provided. Provide custom photo finishing services for prints larger than 10 inches by 30 inches (but smaller than murals). Develop mural displays and provide related illustration and graphics services. Produce and print high-resolution camera-ready art and graphics. Mount and frame artwork for display on exhibit structures as part of the overall concept. Work closely with the COR or Government Representative to ensure all requirements are met as conveyed during initial pre-planning sessions. Provide the Government with original copies of graphics files for future use.

3.3 CLIN X003 Exhibit Support Materials and Travel

The Contractor shall provide necessary materials and equipment associated with the support services listed in paragraph 3.2 above. Examples of exhibit support materials may include: exhibit system structures and hardware (counter tops, doors, support units, cabinetry, electrical components, etc.), graphic materials (signs, photo boards, murals, frames, etc.), carpet, or any other needed material/equipment items. The Contractor shall travel to supported trade shows, conventions, and symposia, as estimated in **Attachment A**. Travel will typically involve one to two persons to supervise exhibit set up and tear down, materials handling, and preparation for shipment at the

remote show site. These efforts will typically require 2.5 days prior to a show and 1.5 days after the show.

3.4 CLIN X004 Show Services (Pass Through)

The Contractor shall arrange and oversee the availability of the following show services as necessary in support of each show. This includes the following: booth cleaning, carpeting, drayage, electrical support, freight to and from show, labor install/dismantle, etc. These services are typically mandated and sourced by the convention site. The Contractor shall advise the Government regarding technical specifications necessary to fulfill the Governments requirements. In support of all exhibitor groups within Team SPAWAR, the Contractor shall arrange the following: Pick up SPAWAR-supplied exhibit materials and equipment at SPAWAR exhibitor groups' shipping and receiving facilities, or other location as specified, for transport to the show site, and return materials after a show. The materials are supplied by exhibitor groups within SPAWAR and will include materials ranging from graphics materials to computer systems and monitors. Deliver exhibit, including SPAWAR-supplied exhibit materials and equipment, to the exhibition site. Return these materials to storage at the completion of a show.

The Contractor shall arrange for and coordinate all shipping, drayage and other show services, and shall ensure that shipping companies protect delicate electronic equipment. The Contractor shall set-up the exhibit at the show site, ensuring that all materials have been delivered, and dismantle the exhibit at the completion of the show, including packing materials for shipment. The Contractor shall inspect and stow exhibit materials after each show for future use. Depending upon local site policy, the Contractor may be required to supervise the efforts of local labor in setting up and breaking down the exhibit, including coordinating efforts with local labor unions, decorators, Teamsters, electrical, etc. Provide technical expertise when arranging for show services, such as electrical and telephone connections and specifications, T-1 lines, hubs, and internet connectivity, lead retrieval, on-site rentals, and other services, based on the needs of the specific exhibit and as requested by the Government. Ensure all required exhibit services are ordered for each exhibition. This includes the following: Material handling/drayage (inbound *and* outbound), in-booth forklift and labor, installation and dismantling labor, hanging sign/truss labor, storage (during show), marshaling yard and direct delivers, electrical specifications (services and labor), telephone, network service (internet connectivity), booth cleaning, catering, rentals, including computer and audio visual equipment, lead retrieval, plants, carpet, furniture and accessories, specialty furniture.

3.5 CLIN X005 DATA DELIVERABLES (NSP – Not Separately Priced)

Deliverables under this contract shall be in accordance with the Contract Data Requirements List, CDRL DD Form 1423, as specified below. Contractor The Contractor shall provide the following deliverables in accordance with the below listed schedule:

5.0 SECURITY

This contract does not involve classified material or access.

6.0 PLACE OF PERFORMANCE

The work shall be performed at the Contractor's facility and at show sites within the Continental United States, and possibly Hawaii. The Contractor's storage facility shall be within 30 miles of SPAWAR Headquarters office located at 4301 Pacific Highway, San Diego, CA. 92110. This requirement is based on the need to access the exhibits on a frequent basis for the purposes of planning, organizing, and preparing for a show. The Contractor shall accommodate an average of two such visits per month.

7.0 Wide Area Work Flow (WAWF) Invoicing Requirements

The Contractor shall notify the COR via e-mail when the Contractor submits invoices to WAWF. The Contractor shall also provide a soft copy of the invoice and any supporting documentation as requested by the COR in order to assist the COR in validating the invoiced amount against the services provided during the billing cycle and completing the Invoice Review Form provided.

8.0 Contractor Employee Identification

For all services provided by the Contractor under this PWS and associated Task Order, the Contractor's employees shall identify themselves as Contractor personnel by introducing themselves as Contractor personnel and displaying distinguishing badges or other visible identification for meetings with Government personnel. Additionally, the Contractor's personnel shall appropriately identify themselves as Contractor employees in telephone conversations and in formal and informal written correspondence.
