Ladies and Gentlemen:

Amendment 0005 to Request for Proposals (RFP) N66001-03-R-5025 is hereby issued to amend the solicitation and extend the hour and date specified for the receipt of offers.

RFP N66001-03-R-5025 was issued on May 8, 2003, as a competitive 100% small business set-aside, for the acquisition of financial management information systems support services. The RFP's Statement of Work included tasking in nine broad areas including section 3.8 titled "Financial Business System Support" for Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) system integration and development support. The RFP was based on an independent Government cost estimate of \$30,473,500 inclusive of a two year base period of performance and a three year option period of performance. The RFP closed for the receipt of offers at 2:00 pm Pacific Daylight Saving Time on June 9, 2003.

Subsequent to the receipt of offers, the Space and Naval Warfare Systems Center, San Diego (SSC San Diego) determined that the pace of convergence towards a common Department of the Navy ERP system, funded by the Navy ERP Program Management Office, has accelerated - thereby eliminating the need for technical support of "Project Cabrillo" ERP systems at SSC San Diego. Because the RFP's independent Government cost estimate projected significant costs related to ERP system integration and development support, and a need for such support is no longer envisioned at SSC San Diego, the RFP has been amended to remove ERP system integration and development support tasking from the Statement of Work, and permit the submission of new or revised offers.

Amendment 0005 is accordingly issued to extend the hour and date specified for the receipt of offers until 2:00 pm Pacific Daylight Saving Time on July 14, 2003. Amendment 0005 includes a detailed explanation of all changes to the RFP and its attachments. Among the changes are a revision to the Statement of Work, a restructuring of the period of performance, a decrease in the estimated level of effort, and the addition of new clauses. The revised independent Government cost estimate is \$19,957,354. A conformed copy of the RFP and its attachments, incorporating all changes, is issued with Amendment 0005 and is available at the SPAWAR e-Commerce Central web site URL <http://e-commerce.spawar.navy.mil/>.

Previously submitted offers will not be further considered, but may be modified and re-submitted in accordance with RFP instructions. The Government will accept proposals from all eligible, qualified small business offerors including offerors who did not previously submit a proposal. (See clause H-1000 that prohibits certain contractors, who may be otherwise qualified, from participating in this solicitation.)

SSC San Diego regrets any inconvenience this action may cause. We believe that it would be inappropriate, however, to proceed with an evaluation of submitted proposals knowing that approximately one-third of the originally estimated tasking will not materialize. We strive to conduct business in an open manner, so that our partners in industry can make the most informed decisions effecting their financial interests.
