Solicitation No. N66001-04-R-0028, Statement of Work, dated 20 Jan 2004, Paragraph 5.0 states, "There is no Government furnished property or equipment associated with this contract."</p> <p>2. Fabrication Specification (55910-0207773) dated 20 Jan 2004, paragraph 4.1.3 and Table 1 require the contractor to perform the tests in Dwg #0207247 or Dwg #0202588, and reference the use of Appendix I for the Data Sheets.</p> <p>Step 15 in both the Dwg #0207247 and Dwg #0202588 tests require the use of a Mk7 Shipset (0207063) for the performance of that step. Although the Fabrication Specification (55910-0207773) Appendix I, (page 40) describes Operational Testing that is the Governments responsibility, the Step 15 tests describe the use of a bowl of water with the Mk7, clearly not the Appendix I Operational Tests.</p> <p>Will the Step 15 tests in Dwg #0207247 and Dwg #0202588 be designated Government Responsibility, or in lieu of that, deleted? If the Step 15 tests remain as stated in Dwg #0207247 and Dwg #0202588, will a Mk 7 Shipset (0207063) be provided as Government furnished property?</p>
	A	<p><b>1. Yes. The statement of work is correct that "there is no Government furnished property or equipment associated with this contract".</b></p> <p><b>2. Step 15 tests in Dwg #0207247 and Dwg #0202588 are Government's responsibilities; therefore, there won't be any Government furnished equipment.</b></p>
